DAVID HOROWITZ TO SPEAK ON ISLAMO-FACISM AT UW- MILWAUKEE

MILWAUKEE – Former Marxist and liberal activist turned conservative David Horowitz will be speaking at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee on Wednesday, April 30th, announced AJ Piwarun, Executive Director of the UWM Conservative Union said this afternoon. “We’re enthused that a speaker of David’s caliber will be speaking at UWM on an important issue like the threat of radical Islam”.

David Horowitz was born in 1939 to a Jewish family in Queens, and quickly became an activist for left wing politics and the civil rights movement. He quickly became acquainted with Black Panther leader Huey P. Newton, and provided legal and financial assistance to the organization.

Growing under his “second thoughts”, Horowitz and his associate Peter Collier committed to a new cause, asserting what they called a “new left” in baby-boomer academia. With his “second thoughts”, he became an opponent of affirmative action and a proponent of interventionist foreign policy.

His conversion to conservative thought brought about speaking engagements, the drafting of an “Academic Bill of Rights”, and many best-selling books including “Unholy Alliance: Radical Islam and the American Left”, “Indoctrination U: The Left’s War against Academic Freedom”, and his autobiography “Radical Son: A Generational Odyssey”.

“The UWM Conservative Union believes Islamo-facism and the War on Terror is an important topic, especially in academic settings”, said Tyler Kristopeit, the Communications Director of the UWM Conservative Union.

David Horowitz’s speech will take place on April 30th at 7:30pm, in the UWM Union’s Wisconsin Room.

David’s speech will be the conclusion of a series of speeches held at UWM this year by the Conservative Union, which has included conservative author-scholars Walid Shoebat, Peter Schweizer, Dinesh D’Souza, and Bay Buchanan.
